Dear Member

I wrote to you on 22 March 2023 giving notice in accordance with Article 118 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Northern Ireland) Order 1995 of new continuous action short of strike action instructions following a lawful ballot of members, which commenced on 3 April 2023. I wrote further on 3 April 2023, giving notice of discontinuous strike action. I wrote again on 20 November 2023 giving notice of half a day of discontinuous strike action which took place on 29 November 2023.

I now write to give notice in accordance with the above Order of one day of strike action. The strike action will be discontinuous and take place on:

Thursday 18 January 2024

Essentially, this instruction as issued will apply to all NASUWT members including:

- classroom teachers;
- substitute teachers;
- vice-principals;
- principals.

This strike action instruction also applies to all NASUWT members working in grant-aided schools or employed directly by the Education Authority on teachers' terms and conditions of employment. This includes all schools in the following categories:

- controlled;
- maintained;
- voluntary grammar;
- integrated.

For the avoidance of doubt, the continuous action short of strike action that commenced on Tuesday 3 April 2023 remains in place and will remain in place apart from when the strike action you are now being notified of takes place.

Thank you for your solidarity and support during what I know has been a difficult period for you all.
